### ALL MATERIALS ARE READY TO BE LAUNCHED!

During the last months each partner has been piloting the Sticks'n'Stones project materials with their local schools and now everything is getting ready to be officially launched on the project's e-platform.

Each partner has tested the material with the three different target groups of the project:

### PILOTING WITH SCHOOL COMMITTEES AND TEACHERS:

2 school committees per partner country have been chosen to evaluate the CPD (continuous professional development) training from IO2. Each school committee comprises a representative from the parents, a representative from the school staff and 3 teachers. Afterwards a training on the CPD program for teachers has also been carried out so teachers have learned how to produce their own digital resources and infographics with their students.

## PILOTING WITH THE STUDENTS

The learning materials aimed at primary school students and their learning on how to avoid bullying have been tested and we have to say that they have been very well accepted!

### PILOTING WITH PARENTS

The third stage of our piloting was the workshops with 10 parents. Each partner country has conducted two workshops with 10 parents each to show them the digital resources we have prepared for them. They will get some tips and activities to work with their children either if their son or daughter is a victim, a bully or a bystander.
























# SEE YOU IN OSTRAVA!
